<u>Intro</u>

Amoke Foundation (AF) is a charitable organisation focused on Sickle Cell Disease (SCD), aimed at providing patient-centred programs for medically underserved communities in sub-Saharan Africa by working in partnership with teaching hospitals to facilitate clinical trials of new drugs and implement new treatment protocols to alleviate the sufferings of SCD patients in these areas.

Request

A couple of SCD patients have approached the foundation for assistance with major hip replacement surgery due to Avascular Necrosis, a complication arising from sickle cell disease.

Case 1

100 Level female student at University of Benin (UNIBEN) who attends the Amoke clinic @ UCH, Ibadan. The painful condition which affects her mobility and impedes her ability to attend lectures regularly.

Case 2

A final year female microbiology student of Kwara State University (KWASU). She requires a bilateral hip replacement and currently immobile, in excruciating pain and unable to continue her education.





Amoke Foundation is appealing to well-wishers and philanthropists to assist these young ladies in funding the cost of the operation. This will improve the quality of their lives considerably and enable them to contribute positively to the economy on completion of their university education.

Each operation will cost N2.5m, but AF is partnering with qualified orthopaedic surgeons locally to ensure that the intervention is professionally handled with satisfactory outcomes on each case. AF is also able to negotiate a cost reduction arising from economy of scale.
